<u>Formative Assessment</u>-Assessment <u>for</u> learning. These are practice. *Examples include: entry task, exit ticket, practice performance, formal written, online quiz, personal response system questions, verbal response, checklist, fist to five, red-yellow-green light, thumbs up-down-sideways, journal entry, student discourse, practice Pacer test.*
