

## **Washington Discovery Academy Uniform Policy and Expectations**

### **Purpose:**

The purpose of our uniform policy is to provide all students with common expectations and remove any potential distractions from the learning environment. With some of the changes this year, we are also emphasizing professional dress during our presentations.

**Parents are expected to cooperate with the school by having their student adhere to the uniform guidelines.**

### **Shirts and blouses**

1. Shirts should be solid black, red, white, or grey with or without the Washington Discovery Academy logo.
2. Shirts can be t-shirts, short or long sleeved, with or without a collar.
3. Any emblems or logos should be no larger than one inch.
4. Shirts should be tucked in on presentation days.

### **Pants, skirts, and dresses**

1. Pants, shorts and skirts can be black or khaki. Skirts should be to the fingertip of the index finger or longer. No denim material is allowed.
2. Dresses and jumpers can be black, khaki, or red of solid color.
3. Students may wear athletic pants or shorts but they must be in a solid color of black or khaki with any emblems less than one inch.
4. Leggings and yoga pants are NOT appropriate unless worn under an appropriate skirt, dress, or jumper.

**Outerwear** (Ex: sweatshirts, sweaters, cardigans worn inside during the day. Coats and jackets that are worn outside do not have to conform to the expectations)

1. Outerwear should be worn in black, red, white, gray with or without the Washington Discovery Academy Logo.
2. Any emblems or logos should be no larger than one inch.

### **Shoes**

Shoes are to be closed-toe. No sandals or flip-flops.

### **Jeans and out of uniform days**

Jeans and non-uniform days are designated by the principal only.
