- Enrollment in a dual credit course allows you to earn high school credit AND college credit.
- This college credit may be transferable to the college of your choice.
- This college credit is transferable to all Indiana public universities.
- Dual credit courses expose students to the rigors of college work.
- Students enrolled in dual credit courses are more likely to apply to college.
- Dual credit enhances skills required to be successful at the collegiate level.
- Dual credit offers students the opportunity to explore possible career areas of interest.

## WHAT OPTIONS DOES PLYMOUTH HIGH SCHOOL OFFER FOR DUAL CREDIT?

### **ACP (Advanced College Project) through Indiana University South Bend**

- Cost is minimal (\$25 per credit)
- No credentialing required to earn credit
- Application Process and GPA requirements

### **Ivy Tech**

- Cost is free
- Some courses require students to “credential” to earn college credit through testing via Accuplacer, SAT, ACT or PSAT
