BUTTE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1 BOARD OF TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING APRIL 18, 2022

The Board of Trustees held a Regular Meeting on Monday, April 18, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. at the East Middle School Library with Chairperson Ann Boston presiding. Trustees present were Patti Hepola, Tom Billteen, Susanne Dauenhauer, Kelly Lee Frank Joseph and Quinton Queer. Trustee Klobucar was absent. Also present were Judy Jonart, Superintendent, Karen Alley, Director of Human Resource and Kevin Patrick, Director of Business Affairs.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

<u>Item 1 – Special Board Meeting, March 21, 2022</u>

Trustee Lee made motion to approve, second by Trustee Hepola. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>Item 2 – Regular Board Meeting, March 21, 2022</u>

Trustee Billteen made motion to approve, second by Trustee Joseph. Motion carried unanimously.

Item 3 - Special Board Meeting, April 1, 2022

Trustee Dauenhauer made motion to approve, second by Trustee Lee. Motion carried unanimously.

COMMUNICATIONS

Item 4 - Kennedy Elementary School Presentation

Travis Johnson, Kennedy Elementary School Principal, updated the Board on Kennedy Elementary School.

Mr. Johnson opened his presentation with a drawing of John F. Kennedy, by 6th grader Maizee Foley. Miss Foley drew the President freehand. The drawing is now framed and hanging in the hall at Kennedy Elementary School.

Mr. Johnson informed the Board about the Student of the Month, Accelerated Reader, Kindle Fire Award, Hay Rides, Sno Flinga, 50 Days of School, 100 Days of School, STEM/Classroom Activities, Sports, Sledding and Skiing, and Brag Tags.

Mr. Johnson wanted to thank the teachers who are coaching the Kennedy Crusaders. These teachers are giving their time to help the school. He also thanked all the Kennedy Staff.

Judy Jonart, Superintendent, wanted to thank the sponsors of the ski programs as well as Mr. Johnson and all of his staff. Ann Boston thanked Mr. Johnson and his staff on behalf of the Board and asked that Mr. Johnson also congratulate Maizee Foley on her terrific drawing.

<u>Item 5 – Audit Presentation</u>

Kevin Patrick, Director of Business Affairs, informed the Board the School District received a clean audit from Newland and Company. The Board congratulated Mr. Patrick.

Judy Jonart, Superintendent, told the Board that this was not easy to do and thanked Mr. Patrick and his staff.

<u>Item 6 – Update – Required Testing for Lead in Butte School District Schools Drink Water</u>

Jeremey Whitlock, Director of Transportation, Building and Maintenance, explained that the 2020 Legislature required testing be complete by December 2022.

Butte School District No. 1 has approximately 389 fixtures, with 182 requiring testing. 5 were over the action level after testing and before flushing. These 5 fixtures were out of commission for years. After flushing, 2 fixtures were still over the action level. These will remain turned off and fixtures will be replaced over the summer.

A flushing program has been implemented district wide.

Trustee Joseph asked if the lead was in the water or in the fixtures. Mr. Whitlock said it is in the fixtures because they are so old. Our city water is fine.

Trustee Billteen asked how often we would be testing. Mr. Whitlock said every 3 years.

Judy Jonart, Superintendent, said this was a vey extensive amount of work and she was thrilled with the results and thanked Mr. Whitlock for all of his hard work.

<u>Item 7 – Update of ARP</u>

Judy Jonart, Superintendent, updated the Board on the ARP. There are no changes, we are moving forward.

The Unit ventilators will now not be delivered until July.

As of April 4, 2022, 4 students have tested positive for COVID-19 and there were 6 new cases in Butte-Silver Bow.

<u>Item 8 – Update on High School Association Boys Baseball</u>

Chuck Merrifield, Athletic Director, updated the Board on the prospect of Butte High Boys Baseball. Start-up costs would be about \$30,000 with a yearly cost to run a baseball program at \$40,500. Transportation and hotel costs have doubled and keep rising. The are looking into ticket prices, activity fees, advertising revenue, fundraising, tournament revenue, etc. Mr. Merrifield is not sure how many AAs are adding the program in 2023 or 2024 but he believes this is something we should be offering our kids.

MHSA needs a decision by end of May. Mr. Merrifield will bring more refined numbers and funding sources back to the Board's May meeting.

Judy Jonart, Superintendent, reported that they are also currently reviewing the contract with Butte-Silver Bow for 3 Legends Stadium.

<u>Item 9 – 1st Reading – Early childhood Education Enrollment Exceptional Circumstances – 1010FE/3100</u>

Judy Jonart, Superintendent, presented the 1st Reading of Policy 1010FE/3100. This is a new policy and allows us to offer early childhood education to certain kids who meet poverty requirements. This would add seats similar to what we already offer at Emerson. We would collect ANB for these students.
