## **GLS Guided Study Program**

Starting on Tuesday, September 2, 2025, the After School Guided Study Program will be offered on regular school days, M-Th, from 3:15 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. for students in grades 4-8. (Students will be given a supervised break time between 2:45 p.m. and 3:15 p.m.) Students may attend on a regular schedule of days (for example, every TTh) or come only as needed when prearranged with the student's homeroom teacher and parents.

During the sessions, students will have an opportunity to complete homework, utilize technology resources, and receive assistance from teachers where needed. Communication will take place with classroom teachers in order to obtain assignments and priorities.

At the end of each afternoon session, parents may pick their child up from the gym doors of the school building promptly at 5:00 p.m. Additionally, an activity bus will be available for students to ride home at 5:00 p.m., if preferred. In order to ride the activity bus, permission paperwork must be submitted in advance. Students who are consistently picked up after the 5:00 p.m. ending time will be required to ride the activity bus in order to continue with the program.
