



## State of Illinois Health Requirements 2021 – 2022 School Year

Dear Parents,

Welcome to Butler School District 53! Whether your child is starting kindergarten, junior high, or joining our school district at any grade for the first time, it is an exciting time and we want them to be prepared to begin. All children entering Illinois schools are required to have a physical examination and provide proof of required vaccinations. Please use the guidelines below to ensure that all the required health forms are complete.

### **Health Examination**

The State of Illinois requires all children to present a current physical exam, including all required immunization dates upon entry to a public school for preschool, kindergarten, and sixth grade. **Please be sure to complete and sign the parent portion on back side of form. Scan and upload to your student's PowerSchool portal. Incomplete forms will be returned to you.**

The following areas of the physical exam must be completed by your physician before leaving the doctor's office including; Diabetes Screening, BMI, Lead Risk Questionnaire, Emergency Action (if applicable), and Physical Education participation. **The Health Examination and Immunizations are due August 16, 2021.**

### **Sports Physicals**

All students planning to participate in an extracurricular school activity requires a current sport physical (completed within a year) and a signed concussion form on file in health office **prior to student try outs.**

### **Immunizations**

Please refer to the [State Medical Requirements by Grade](#) below and on our website to view all Illinois State required immunizations needed for school entry. All incoming 6<sup>th</sup> grade students must now show evidence of receiving one Meningococcal Vaccine (MCV4).

### **Dental Examination**

The State of Illinois requires a dental examination for all children entering kindergarten, second, and sixth grade. The dental exam is due by May 15<sup>th</sup> of the school year.

### **Eye Examination**

The State of Illinois requires an eye exam for all children entering kindergarten and any student entering an Illinois Public School for the first time. The eye examination is due by October 15<sup>th</sup> of the school year.

I suggest you schedule your child's appointments early as doctor's offices get busy over the summer months.
