- Support language during reading centers in the classroom
- Teach functional life skills class
- Direct intervention services to students in the least restrictive environment (include classroom-based service)
- Indirect intervention and consultative services to teachers and school staff
- Other site-based and special education duties, including support of district literacy goals
- Promote play and development of problem solving skills



- Assist with development and implementation of S.T.A.C.K. (School-wide Technology and Augmentative Communication for Kids) Program: programming and use of iPads for communication for children that limited communication skills.
