Craft Corner

Milk Carton Bug Catcher

A cut window in two opposite sides of a milk carton. Place carton in the foot of a nylon stocking. Catch a bug and place in the carton. Secure the top of stocking by tying a knot or using a twist seal.



Egg Carton Spider

Poke four holes near open edge of the egg carton cup. Thread a pipe cleaner halfway through one hole. Bend in half to form two legs. Repeat the process with other holes. Paint it brown or black.
