**Steel Valley School District Town Hall Meeting Date CHANGED...
*Event Rescheduled to Tuesday, Oct. 29***

Munhall, PA – Steel Valley School District’s “Town Hall Meeting,” will now be held on Tuesday, Oct. 29 at 6 p.m. in the High School Auditorium. The event was previously scheduled for Oct. 28.

During this first-time meeting, discussion will be held regarding possible options for educating all District students together in grades K – 12. Currently, the District operates two neighborhood elementary schools for students in grades K – 4.

According to Superintendent Edward Wehrer, the meeting will be one of multiple ways in which the District plans to gain input from its stakeholders about the possible reconfiguration of Barrett and Park Elementary schools. Staff surveys, parent surveys and student surveys will be utilized along with additional Town Hall meetings this fall and winter.

“We have not finalized any thinking, but we do aim to have a plan in place by the end of winter that will bring our students together for their entire educational experience at Steel Valley. Right now, our students are together for grades 5 – 12, but not for grades K – 4,” said Wehrer. “While we certainly will be mindful of expenses, we want to focus on building the best instructional system we can for our students. The community has the opportunity to contribute to our common goal, which is a stronger Steel Valley.”
