- Always remain with my group and not leave the program without permission.
- Use program equipment and supplies properly.
- Not bring cell phones and other electronic devices on the course.
- Participate appropriately. I will not disrupt the program experience of others.
- Understand that any violations of the above rules will be cause for removal.
