Re: National School Lunch Program for the 2020-21 School Year

Dear SD81 Parents and Guardians,

Below is important information regarding procedures for the National School Lunch Program. Please be advised of the following:

- August 12th, 2020 is the last day the Illinois State Board of Education will fund the Seamless Summer Meals program, which provides meals for children 18 years and younger, regardless of what school they attend, in order to ensure children are fed through the summer months. District 81 will only provide meals to enrolled District 81 students after August 12th.
- Please complete the Free and Reduced meal application form that will be sent to each family and return it to your child's school upon pick up of their iPad and supplies on August 18th.
- August 17th, 2020 will be the first day of the 2020-21 National School Lunch and Breakfast Program for District 81 schools.
- Parents and guardians will receive their student's ID card (barcoded) which MUST be presented to pick up meals beginning August 19th. These ID cards will be distributed by your child's school upon pick up of their iPad and supplies on August 18.
- Meals for all students (Kennedy, Washington, Lincoln) will be distributed at Lincoln Middle School at Door 1 on Mondays and Wednesdays from 11 am - 12 pm. Grab and go bags will contain breakfast and lunch for the subsequent days until the next pick up. Please remember to wear a mask when picking up your meals.
- Please email pmaranto@sd81.org or call the district office at 847-671-1816 if you are unable to pick up the meals. Arrangements can be made for delivery by District 81 staff.
- Families who do not qualify to receive free or reduced meals have the option to pay for their child's meals. They will follow the above procedures and their bill will be updated in PowerSchool. Please email pmaranto@sd81.org or call the District office so we can prepare the correct number of meals.
