Grades 4-8

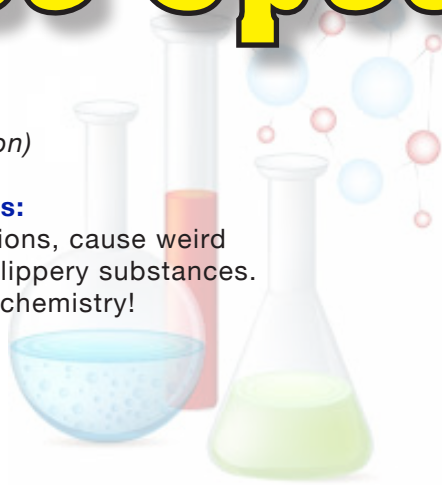
(Two 75-minute classes)
