When a child is first judged to be absent from school for an unexcused reason, the school authorities shall attempt to deal with the problem at the school level. <li data-bbox="544 388 1372 420">2. The parents or guardian must be informed of the unexcused absence. <li data-bbox="544 451 1437 829">3. Other possible steps to be taken shall include any or all of the following as deemed necessary: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li data-bbox="641 546 1356 577">a. Disciplinary action such as P.M.s or in-school suspension. <li data-bbox="641 609 868 640">b. Counseling. <li data-bbox="641 672 917 703">c. Core Evaluation. <li data-bbox="641 735 1404 766">d.
