<p><u>651.</u></p> <p>Solicitations</p> <p>Amended 3/5/03</p> <p>Adopted 6/18/03</p>	<p>The following policy guidelines serve to provide guidance to the school administration and to prevent the misuse of the school organization regarding the solicitation of students:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Students and the school organization shall not be used as a means of collecting information that is not directly related to the conduct of the school program or school-related activities.</li> <li>2. There shall be no solicitation or canvassing of students and families by any non-school organization, without the specific permission of the superintendent of schools.</li> <li>3. No employee may release the names and addresses of students to persons or organizations outside the schools, except as required by law and with the specific approval of the superintendent of schools.</li> </ol>	
<p><u>652.</u></p> <p>Gifts to School Personnel</p> <p>Adopted 3/5/80</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Gifts by parents or students to school personnel are not encouraged.</li> <li>2. The School Committee subscribes to the general tenet that any action or comment by a staff member, which might be interpreted as an invitation for a gift of any nature, is unethical.</li> </ol>	
<p><u>653.</u></p> <p>Errand for School Staff</p> <p>Adopted 3/5/80</p>	<p>No student will be sent off the school grounds on personal errands by any school employee.</p>
