

GENERAL LAWS	RIGHTS OF STUDENTS (Not elsewhere noted)	720
Ch. 71, S.86	Sections on rights of students as given in Chapter 70, Sections 82-85 apply to cities and towns which accept the same.	
Ch. 71, S.82	Gives rights of students with regard to expressing and publishing their views and their right to assemble peaceably a right “shall not be abridged, provided that such right shall not cause any disruption or disorder within the school.”	
Ch. 71, S.83	“School officials shall not abridge the rights of students to personal dress and appearance except if such officials determine that such personal dress and appearance violate reasonable standards health, safety and cleanliness.”	
Ch. 71, S.85	Board of Education may (and has) adopted guidelines on student rights. Rules and regulations shall be established only after due notice and public hearing. Subject to a possible later requested hearing, school committees and school officials may take necessary action in cases of emergency.	
Ch. 51, S.42B	On petition of twenty-five or more unregistered students of voting age, the principal shall request registrar or election commissioner to hold one voter registration session at the school during the school year.
