

GENERAL LAWS	PROVISIONS OF BUILDINGS	810
Ch. 15, S.1G	The board of education has power to establish minimum standards for all public school buildings, subject to the provisions of the state building code.	
Ch. 15, S.1F	The Division of School Facilities and Related Services has the responsibility for assisting towns with the construction and major renovation of school buildings.	
Ch. 44, S.31C	A contract for building a school is not “deemed to have been made” until the town auditor or accountant has certified that sufficient funds have been appropriated.	
Ch. 71, S.68	A town shall provide sufficient “schoolhouses.” The town shall appoint at least one member of the school committee to any school building committee.	
Ch. 71, S.4	A town may lease land and buildings for educational purposes for a period not to exceed five years.
