Ch. 70, S.7	Requires local communities to spend at a certain level in order to qualify for school aid from the state.	
Ch. 70, S.8	Provides manner in which state school aid is to be spent.	
Ch. 40, S.4B	Unless exception made by by-law (or policy) or there is a case of special emergency, mandated bidding procedures must be used in order to purchase equipment, supplies or materials, the actual or estimated cost of which amounts to \$2,000 or more.	
Ch. 268A	See Reference 110 for relevant sections of the "conflict of interest" statute which relates to purchasing.	
Ch. 7, S.22A	State government given power to go out to bid on many types of equipment and kinds of supplies used by schools. Schools can then purchase these items at prices established by this bidding procedure.	
Ch. 74, S.55	Allows schools and other non-profit agencies to purchase federal surplus property at prices considerably below market value.
