**MINUTES OF SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETING, EXECUTIVE SESSION

Executive Session convened at 8:54 PM.

**Issue:** Negotiations with SEA

**Discussion:** Ms. Malone, Mr. Samia, and Ms. Fryc updated the committee with regard to contract negotiations with the SEA, including a recent meeting with counsel, Mr. James Toomey. The issues of professional development and sick leave buyback were discussed, as well as the status of the most recent financial proposals. A discussion was held regarding collective bargaining strategy. The next meeting between the School Committee negotiating team and the SEA had been scheduled for Tuesday, September 17.

**Issue:** Residency status of a student

**Discussion:** Dr. Sawyer presented the committee with a memorandum from Shrewsbury High School Principal Mr. Todd Bazydlo, dated September 5, recommending that grade 12 student Caroline Gilbody, whose family had moved to Sutton, be allowed to complete her senior year at SHS. On a motion from Dr. Magee, seconded by Ms. Canzano, the committee voted unanimously to permit Ms. Gilbody to complete her senior year in Shrewsbury Public Schools.
