




Program Highlights





Impact of Turf Field

- Reduced the number of events postponed due to weather.
- Boys and Girls Lacrosse teams were able to start on time and play in the stadium for the first time.
- Over 60 contests have been played since October 2018 compared to about 35-40 in the fall season only in previous years.
- Field Rentals to youth organizations for the first time.
- Hosted numerous MIAA events that led to home field advantage in soccer and field hockey playoffs.
- Less work needed in stadium allowed for Parks and Recreation Department to focus on other fields at the high school and town.
