Home school children are not enrolled in the public-school system. Consequently, they are neither required nor entitled to take state mandated tests (i.e. MCAS/PARCC etc.). They are also prohibited from participation in academic or co-curricular programs of the Shrewsbury Public Schools.

REMINDER: Parents must officially withdraw the student (s) from the current school. The withdrawal should take place after this application has been approved.

INSTRUCTIONS/ INFORMATION

- For students new to the Shrewsbury Public Schools, please provide a proof of residence in the town of Shrewsbury. (Three forms are required for proof: signed lease agreement, deed, real estate tax bill, SELCO bill, water/sewer bill, gas/propane/oil bill.)
- For current students in Shrewsbury Public Schools wishing to homeschool parent/guardian must alert the district in writing before the start of school by completing this application.

Applications must include information about the parent's/guardian's academic credentials or other qualifications, a brief description of the proposed educational plan, the kind of educational materials the parents/guardians expect to use and the plan for evaluation of the student's progress on an annual basis. For additional details you may want to review the district policy on homeschooling on our website.

Applications must also include the student's previous end-of year assessment. (school records or homeschool portfolio).

The mission of Shrewsbury Public Schools, in partnership with the community, is to provide students with the skills and knowledge for the 21st century, an appreciation of our democratic tradition, and the desire to continue to learn throughout life. In pursuit of this mission, curriculum, instruction and assessment practices are continuously evaluated and adapted to ensure our students social and academic needs are met.

The parent/guardian bears the responsibility of demonstrating that the homeschool instruction will equal in thoroughness and efficacy to that of the Shrewsbury Public Schools.

Shrewsbury Public Schools follow the Massachusetts Curriculum Frameworks. https://www.doe.mass.edu/frameworks/current.html

A curriculum description and schedule must be submitted for each child who will be educated at home.

The compulsory attendance statute (MA Law Chapter 76,1) requires that students attend an approved program from age 6 to their 16th birthday. Parents/guardians of a 5-year-old who will turn 6 by December 31st should submit written notification to the superintendent of their plans to homeschool before the beginning of the school year. Parents of a child who will turn 6 after December 31st may submit home school plans for the following school year. Parents/guardians should give the superintendent two weeks to consider their program.

Previously homeschooled students entering district schools are treated as students entering from other independent programs for grade placement. Students transferring will be placed at the assumed grade level, but the superintendent will reserve the right to test and reassign the student as may be necessary. The granting of high school credit for a previously homeschooled teenager will be considered on an individual basis, but only if the student has appropriate documentation. In addition, any and all state or federally mandated testing requirements must be successfully met in order for said students to be considered for receipt of a high school diploma.

Home-schooled students are not enrolled in the public-school system. Consequently, they are neither required nor entitled to take the MCAS tests, which are designed to measure the academic progress of students enrolled in publicly supported schools and the performance of those schools.

Home-schooled students shall be prohibited from participation in academic or co-curricular programs of the Shrewsbury Public Schools.
