






Enrollment History Preschool - Grade 12




PreK-12 Enrollment by Grade Level




Kindergarten Enrollment History

Increase from Kindergarten to Grade 1






Percentage of Full-Day Kindergarten Students



All kindergarten students were full-time in 2020 due to COVID-19 policies.


As of the 2021-2022 school year, all kindergarten students are full-day due to the opening of the new Beal School.




Beal School Enrollment History




Calvin Coolidge School Enrollment History




Floral Street School Enrollment History




Walter J. Paton School Enrollment History




Spring Street School Enrollment History




Sherwood Middle School Enrollment History




Oak Middle School Enrollment History




Shrewsbury High School Enrollment History




Special Education Out-of-District Placement




Vocational Technical School Enrollment

Grades 9-12: 18 - 20 students (Not including large classes in music and physical education) Overenrolled = 27 or more (24 for science labs)
