

The Goal Setting Process: 2025-2026



25-26 Areas of Focus will Include:

- Literacy curriculum K-8
- Increasing ELA achievement for all
- Strengthen Tier 1 instructional practices
- Career Technical Education at SHS
- Review district practices and policies regarding cell phone use and Artificial Intelligence
- Strengthen math interventions

5 Priorities:

- Launch Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports and Wayfinder SEL curriculum plans K-12
- Continue efforts to reduce rates of chronic absenteeism
- Identify effective prevention and intervention for challenging behaviors
- Address workplace stress and staff wellness initiatives
- Food service improvements
- Discipline data





Commitment to Optimization of Resources

5 Priorities

- 1. Partner with the community to maintain a strong financial foundation
- 2. Hire, support, and retain high-quality, diverse staff
- 3. Maximize family and community partnerships
- 4. Strategically and equitably allocate district resources
- 5. Improve facilities to address overcrowding and infrastructure needs

25-26 Areas of Focus include:

- Build community awareness about the FY2027 budget
- Continue to seek grants and philanthropic funding
- Enhance recruiting and retention techniques to hire and retain excellent staff from a diverse pool
- Secure funding at the fall 2025
 Special Town Meeting to advance to the next phase for a potential SHS expansion and renovation project



Coming Soon: School Improvement Plans

 Each fall, each school's School Council develops a new School Improvement Plan (SIP) for the coming school year



2025-2026 Tentative schedule:

- November 5: SHS SIP
- November 19: Middle Level SIPs
- December 3: K-4 SIPs
- December 17: Parker Road SIP
- SIPs will reflect school-level goals and actions that are aligned with the district's commitments and strategic priorities
