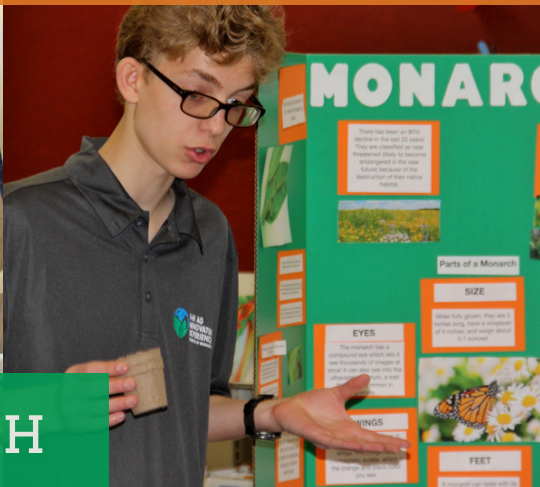


4-H TEEN AMBASSADORS

About the Program

4-H Science & Health Ambassadors receive focused lesson training from 4-H staff, and then can share those projects with community members or lead them for younger youth through supervised, organized activities. The program is designed for youth in grades 6 to 12.

Each fall, 4-H Science Ambassadors will learn the National Youth Science Day project, and then have the opportunity to lead it at various activity dates and locations. Throughout the 4-H year, Science Ambassadors also have the option to be trained in additional project areas and can volunteer to lead those activities at community events and workshops.
