

Frequently asked questions about Summer School 2019:

When and where is it?

Classes are 8am-2pm.

Semester 1:

June 11, 12, 13, 17-20, 24-27 (11 days in total)

Semester 2:

July 1-3, 8-11, 15-18 (11 days in total)

However, depending in total number of weather days off school this year, these dates may need to be adjusted. Please confirm in May that the dates have not been changed.

Summer School will be held at NORTH campus this summer.

How important is attendance?

Attendance is extremely important. If a student misses more than 2 days of school per semester, regardless of the reason, they will need to be withdrawn from summer school and no refund will be issued. Official documentation will not excuse an absence like in regular school year. Each day of summer school is roughly equivalent to an entire week of regular school curriculum. Please plan vacations, sports, camps, etc. outside of the summer school program.

When can I sign up for summer school driver education class?

Registration for driver ed begins Feb. 1 for students that will be 15 years old by June 11, 2019. It is first-come-first-serve, and a wait list will be formed if necessary.

When can I sign up for regular classes in summer school?

In the Guidance Office at both North and South, students can sign up April 1st – May 30th. However, classes are filled on a first-come-first-serve basis (as long as you a student residing in the district). We strongly encourage you to register as soon as possible once you know for sure you wish to take the class. This will better ensure you get the class, as well as assist us in making appropriate staffing decisions. If you have not registered before May 30th, our **late registration date** for all students will be **Tuesday June 4th** 9am-3:30pm at **North High only**.

What classes are available?

See Summer School link on our website for registration guide for all summer school class descriptions and program info. All summer school class choices should be discussed with your counselor prior to registering to ensure proper placement. Any class may be cancelled due to insufficient enrollment. Cancellation decisions will be made on Tuesday June 4th and we will make every attempt to notify families by phone.

Where do I sign up for summer school?

Prior to May 30th, please contact your guidance counselor for the registration form and confirmation of the correct class to take. You will likely be asked to come into the guidance office to sign and pay for the class. Late registration is being held on Tuesday June 4th from 9am – 3:30pm at North HS.

How much does summer school cost?

\$210 per semester for in-district students. If a student lives in District 99 boundaries and qualifies for fee waiver during regular school year, summer school cost is waived. Out of district fees are \$420 per semester class.

Is there bus service?

Yes, as long as student lives more than 1.5 miles away from North. We ask that you note the need for bus service on your application. Bus routes will be formed by June 7th, and may differ from a student's regular year bus route, stop, and time. Routes will be posted schools' website and made available in main office for pick-up.

Is there breakfast or lunch served?

Limited food service is available for lunch only. Vending machines will also be working however students are encouraged to bring own change or small bills as change machines are not always available.
