

League to host forum featuring Districts 58, 68 and 99 candidates

DOWNERS GROVE – Candidates for the District 58, District 68 and District 99 school districts will take the stage to introduce themselves and their views to the public at a candidate forum March 25 hosted by the local League of Women Voters chapters, according to a news release from the nonpartisan organization.

The Downers Grove/Woodridge/Lisle League of Women Voters are hosting an open house for the candidates running for board spots at the three school districts. The open house will take place at the Lincoln Center Park District Building in Downers Grove.

Doors will open at 3 p.m., and beginning at 3:30 p.m. each candidate will get two to three minutes apiece to address attendees of the event.

After each has finished, candidates will be available to speak to voters and share more information about their goals and views. The event will end by 5 p.m.

The districts cover all or portions



of Downers Grove, Woodridge, Westmont, Darien, Lisle, Bolingbrook and Oak Brook.
