DOWNERS GROVE – Brianna Imgruet, a senior at Downers Grove South High School, will join other musicians from across the nation as part of Music for All's 2017 Honor Band of America, according to a news release from the Honor Band of America.

Imgruet plays trumpet and was selected by audition to rehearse and perform in concert as part of the Music for All National Festival planned March 9 through 11 in Indianapolis.

Imgruet has been playing trumpet since fourth grade and has had many musical accomplishments throughout her high school years, including first chair in Wind Ensemble and first chair in the Illinois Music Education Association's jazz ensemble since her sophomore year. She also earned a spot in the 2016 Honors Performance Series at Carnegie Hall and in the Honor Band of America in Indianapolis for 2016 and 2017.
