CULTURAL IMMERSION

Students will study Spanish and learn about Costa Rica's rich history at the Intercultura Costa Rica Spanish School in their custom-designed beachfront campus in Playa Sámara, Guanacaste. Spanish courses are given in modern, air conditioned classrooms with a view of the ocean, and sometimes teachers will hold class outside in the gardens or on the beach under the shade of palm trees. The school provides our students with computers and free WiFi, tropical gardens leading straight onto the sand (students have time for a quick dip in the ocean during their break!), as well as student social and study areas, rancho, fridge, hammocks, a lounge and outdoor showers. In addition to the immersive study program, students will mingle with the local population visit beach restaurants, experience surfing and kayaking, and learn firsthand about the region's indigenous history.

- Learn and completely immerse in Spanish language and culture at the beautiful beachfront Intercultura Costa Rica Spanish School
