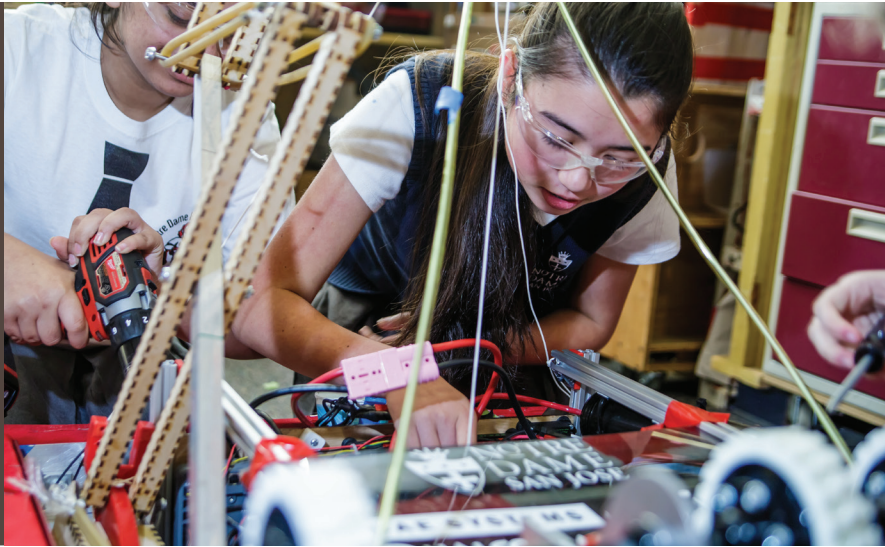


SUPPORTING INNOVATION
