The following Summer Academy classes will be available to our students during the second and third weeks of August:

- **Spring into Second Grade!** (For Incoming 2nd Graders - School Year 2018/19)
This session is academically based and presented in a learning center format. It is designed to review many of the important skills covered in first grade (decoding, sight words, math facts, etc.) in order to prepare for the new school year. **(Academy 601)**
- **Ready for Third Grade?** (For Incoming 3rd Graders – School Year 2018/19)
This session is designed to review many important reading, language, and math skills that were covered in second grade. Be prepared to be successful in third grade. **(Academy 602)**
- **Growing Gardens for Growing Readers** (For Incoming Kindergarten and 1st Graders – School Year 2018/19) A children’s book will be the foundation of each session.
Mon.: Tops & Bottoms – Students will explore the differences between vegetables that grow above and below the soil and identify parts of a plant. Tues.: A Fruit Is a Suitcase for a Seed – Students will dissect vegetables to find and compare seeds. Wed.: The Empty Pot – Students will pain a clay pot and plant flower seeds or mum clippings. Thurs.: The Tiny Seed – The students will explore sunflowers to discover the edible seeds and complete a counting book with the seeds. Culminating event: Students will use a picture guide to walk parents through the garden and highlight their learning from the week. **(Academy 603)**
- **Garden Science** (For Incoming 2nd and 3rd Graders – School Year 2018/19)
All lessons will be connected to informational text resources. Mon.: Needs of Plants – Students will create a garden journal and document plant needs. Tues.: Parts of a Plant – Students will compare/contrast plant features and make connections to the specific needs of different plants. Wed.: Plant Lifecycles – Students will dissect vegetables, explore seeds, and document the life cycle of different plants. They will also paint clay pots and plant seeds or mum clippings. Thurs.: Living Gardens – Students will observe and document the effect lifing things have on a garden (worms, birds, insects, humans). Culminating event: Students will guide their parents on a garden scavenger hunt to demonstrate their knowledge. **(Academy 604)**

- **Float into First Grade!** (For Incoming 1st Graders - School Year 2018/19)
This session is academically based and presented in a learning center format. It is designed to review many of the important skills covered in Kindergarten (alphabet names & sounds, decoding, sight words, phonemic awareness, counting, etc.) in order to prepare for the new school year. **(Academy 605)**
- **Turning Creative Writing into Video Games** (For Incoming 4th-6th Graders – School Year 2018/19) Students will take a piece of creative writing and turn it into their own video games using Bloxels. Time will be spent creating a story, learning how to use Bloxels, and then planning, creating, and playing their own video games. **(Academy 606)**
