## Who Can Come to the Food Pantry?

- Orland Township Residents

Must reside within Orland Township's boundaries: Harlem Avenue (Illinois Route 43) on the east, 135th Street on the north, Will-Cook Road on the west (where Cook County and Will County share a border), and 183rd Street on the south (which is also the Cook-Will county border).

- Orland Township Residents who meet the following criteria:

## When Can Residents Come to the Food Pantry?

Low-income residents are allowed food from the food pantry once a calendar month.

The Orland Township Food Pantry is open Monday-Friday from 9 a.m. until 4 p.m.

## ID Required

All residents ages 19 and older must provide photo ID with proper address.
