### IMMUNIZATIONS

#### Grades 9-12 Entry REQUIREMENTS

- **3 Doses Hepatitis B Vaccine**
- **4 Doses DPT /DTaP** (Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis) **Vaccine**  
(or  $\geq 3$  doses Td plus 1 dose of Tdap)
- **1 Dose of Tdap Vaccine** for grades 7-11  
Tdap is not required for grade 12 but is **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED**  
(in the case of a pertussis outbreak your child could be at risk for illness and/or  
exclusion from school)
- **$\geq 3$  Doses Polio Vaccine**
- **2 Doses of MMR** (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) **Vaccine** for grades 7-11  
(2 doses of measles, one dose of mumps and 1 dose of rubella is acceptable for grade  
12 only) **Please note: First dose must be dated on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday**
- **2 Doses Varicella** (Chicken Pox) **Vaccine** for grades 7-11  
(1 dose is acceptable for grade 12 only) **Please note: First dose must be dated on or  
after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday**  
**Or** a Physician Certified note of chicken pox disease or serological proof of  
immunity
- **A Physical Examination** is required of all students within 12 months prior to  
entrance. It is also required in grade 10, an annually for sports participation.
- **TB Test** – If a student has a Primary Care Physician, it is up to the PCP to determine  
if a TB test or risk assessment, if necessary.

If a student does not have a Primary Care Physician, the school nurse,  
under the guidelines of the School Physician, may do a risk assessment and refer the  
student to the Norwood Board of Health if necessary.
