

French Level 2H Curriculum Overview

Description (including primary objective and outcomes):

In this course, students continue to develop their audio-lingual skills while acquiring more vocabulary and intensifying their study of grammar. More attention is paid to the development of reading and writing skills. Students strengthen their listening comprehension skills both in class and in the language laboratory through the use of CD's and video. The course is conducted as completely as possible in the target language. The history and culture of Francophone countries are examined in more detail.

Learning Experiences:

Hands-on activities, higher-order thinking, cooperative learning, paired activities, individual writing assignments, direct instruction, jigsaw, games, songs, role plays, dialogues, videos, listening comprehension, reading comprehension, information gap activities and speaking activities, power points, guided notes, textbook activities, projects, web quests, competitions, manipulatives, visual aids, stations, transparencies, summarizers, homework.
