<b>Grade</b>	12
<b>Topics</b>	- School Song - Academic Expectations: High School vs. College - Overview of Seniors' morning on PSAT day
<b>Goal</b>	To provide students with insight into how college expectations may differ from those in high school and to have students start thinking more about the transition.
<b>Activities/ Procedures</b>	<p>1. Explain to students that they're all learning the school song for a class competition that will take place during a February Advisory. (The lyrics and Ashley Nelson's version of the song have their own link under the Advisory website.)</p> <p>In regards to Academic expectations: high school vs. college...</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Ask students what they've heard about the differences between high school and college academics (rigor, homework, free time, etc.)</li><li>2. Break students up into groups of 3 or 4</li><li>3. Have each group complete the "High School Versus College Academic Expectation Chart" based on their assumptions.</li><li>4. Review answers and provide feedback (see Academic Expectations Advisor Reference Sheet)</li></ol> <p>- Review the program agenda for seniors on PSAT day, October 15<sup>th</sup> (see attached sheet – you don't have to give one out to everyone)</p>
