<b>Activities/ Procedures</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. We haven't seen your groups in a while so it would be a great idea to play catch-up by having open discussion for a few minutes.</li><li>2. Provide an overview of the "Free Rice" initiative</li><li>4. Generate discussion about being active participants in local and community service projects and initiatives.</li><li>5.
