Reading: We provide services for students who present with a language based learning disability. These services include; remediation in decoding, encoding, reading comprehension, written expression and fluency.

Writing: We provide intensive instruction in the writing process focusing on a well-developed, organized essay, with supporting details and proper mechanics.

Math: We provide best practice in math using an instructional approach and build conceptual understanding and math skills which increase student's ability to use mathematics in problem solving situations.

Reading: Research based instruction in phonics, fluency, and comprehension.

Writing: Research based instruction in all aspects of the writing process; planning, organizing, writing, editing, and re-writing.
