### Pragmatic Social Skills:

PLC staff work closely with the speech and language pathologist and adjustment counselor to provide pragmatic language support. A grade-specific weekly lunch bunch provides an additional opportunity to practice appropriate social behavior in the cafeteria. 1st and 2nd graders participate in daily morning meeting which includes: greetings, calendar, previewing the day for any schedule changes or important information to know, Win-Lose Games, & How to Be a "Good Sport."

Students' academic support is delivered according to their IEP with accommodations and modifications being made by the general education and special education staff.

### Eligibility:

A TEAM decision is made based on a student whose disability significantly affects verbal and non-verbal communication, social interaction, and academics.
