

Pre-Vocational

Pre-vocational skills are needed to prepare for the work place.

The students explore a variety of transition activities such as working at Republic Plumbing. Here they have the opportunity to take direction from a non-staff member and execute job tasks such as filing paperwork alphabetically and cleaning the stock room.

Greeting Cards: Students make and sell personal greeting cards with materials they bought from local arts & craft stores. Students then take the orders filled out by school staff or even community members and create the cards. Here students learn how to make shopping list before purchasing materials, count out the money, go shopping, socialize with em-

ployers at the stores and

then make the cards within the classroom. After the cards have been bought and sold, the customers are greeted appropriately from the students and then students take inventory from the sales.

Coffee/muffins: Students bake muffins and make coffee and sell the items to the school staff. Here students learn how to count the money, cook, and sell the final product while acquiring social skills from the customers.
