Norwood Public Schools is proud to announce the establishment of a new and exciting summer opportunity for your child entering grades 1-5 in the fall. This experience is designed for students who would benefit from a continuation of learning opportunities to ensure a successful transition to the next grade.

Highly qualified teachers will provide instruction in literacy and numeracy concepts, including reading readiness, literacy skills of comprehension and writing, hands on mathematics, organizational skills and cooperative games. English as a Second Language services will be provided for ESL students.

The program will be held at the Coakley Middle School - 1315 Washington Street – from 8:30 until noon, beginning on July 6th through August 5th. This is a Monday through Thursday program. No classes will be held on Fridays.

The cost of the program is \$208 for the 19 days of the program. Full payment is required at the time of registration, and please note that we can only accept personal checks, or money orders. Please contact your building principal for specifics.
