Online Courses for DESE Foundations for Inclusive Practice

TEC has teamed up with the MA Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and EDC, Inc. to share the availability of two online courses to help educators meet the needs of all learners in inclusive settings:

- **Foundations for Inclusive Practice: Educator**

These 15-hour, web-based, and self-paced courses are offered at no cost to all MA educators and present a rigorous and engaging sequence of professional development about meeting the needs of all students.
