

Can My Child Go to School Today ?

Please answer all 4 Questions in the blue boxes

Has your child been in close contact with a person who has tested positive for Covid-19 ? (close contact = within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more)

Stay Home - 14 days from date of last contact with positive person

Is your child ill with cold/ flu like symptoms ? (cough, difficulty breathing, body aches, headache, nasal congestion, sore throat, rash, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, vomiting)

Has your child travelled outside the United States or to a state designated as a Covid hot-spot within our country ?

Stay Home – you must quarantine at home for 14 days.

Monitor for symptoms of COVID

Call your Health Care Provider to determine if testing is indicated

Please notify the school if your child tests positive and follow the Return-to-School criteria before returning to school

Return-to-School Criteria

If your child has fever or other symptoms that could be from COVID-19 and does not get tested **OR** is not cleared by their healthcare provider, it is assumed the child has COVID-19 and may not return to school until the following 3 criteria are met:

1. Child has been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medication
2. **AND** child has improved symptoms
3. **AND** at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared

Was your child seen by their healthcare provider and diagnosed with something other than COVID-19 **AND** has your child been fever-free without medication for 24 hours ?
