We are pleased to announce through our partnership with Pelmeds Pharmacy the second clinic for the two-dose Pfizer COVID-19 vaccination for our students, staff ages 12, and up.

Pelmeds assures us they will have enough vaccines for all those who register. We need you to register, so they bring the correct amount of the vaccine! PLEASE do NOT rush to sign up; there is no need to overwhelm their website with registrations.

Parent or Guardian signatures **are required for any students under the age of 18**. Parents/guardians do NOT need to be present, but we do need the signed permission slip. Please make sure to print and sign the **consent form** and have your student bring it to school before the end of the school year, or on the day of the clinic. If you cannot print out the consent form, there are paper copies in the Coakley and High School health offices for your student to take home. Missing consent forms created a bit of a problem at the first clinic. It is highly recommended that you send the consent form to the school nurse ahead of time.

Students and staff should also bring the vaccination card from their first dose with them to the clinic so the second dose can be recorded.

All students will be vaccinated free of charge regardless of insurance coverage. If insured, please enter insurance information in the online registration. Once registered online there is no need to bring an insurance card to the clinic.

Students and staff who have already received their first dose of the Pfizer series at another location are welcome to register to receive their second shot as long as there has been at least 3 weeks between doses.

Since this clinic is after the end of the school year, students, families, staff and community members who have not yet begun the vaccination process are also welcome to attend this clinic to receive their first dose. After 3 weeks they will need to arrange for their second dose themselves. A list of some nearby options follows:
