WHAT IS TITLE I?

Title I is a federal program to help all students receive a quality education and meet their grade level benchmarks.

Kewanee receives over \$500,000 in Title I funds. We are a school wide program. All children in the K-8 schools may receive Title I funding.

- Funds pay for Title I Language Arts and Math teachers and paraprofessionals for Kindergarten through grade eight at Belle Alexander School, Irving School, Central Elementary and Junior High, and Neponset Grade School.
- Funds pay for learning materials.
- Funds pay for technology
- Funds pay for family events
- Funds pay for professional development.
