### What is this dashboard?

ADHS County-Level School Benchmarks This dashboard is used to determine the level of community spread of COVID-19 in Arizona and assist with decision making for the types of delivery model schools may consider.

### Time Frame

This dashboard does not look at the past two weeks due to potential lags in data.

### Substantial Transmission

>100 cases per 100k, >10% percent positivity, >10% COVID-like illness

### Moderate Transmission

10 - 100 cases per 100k, 5 - 10% percent positivity, 5 - 10% COVID-like illness

### Minimal Transmission

<10 cases per 100k, <5% percent positivity, <5% COVID-like illness
