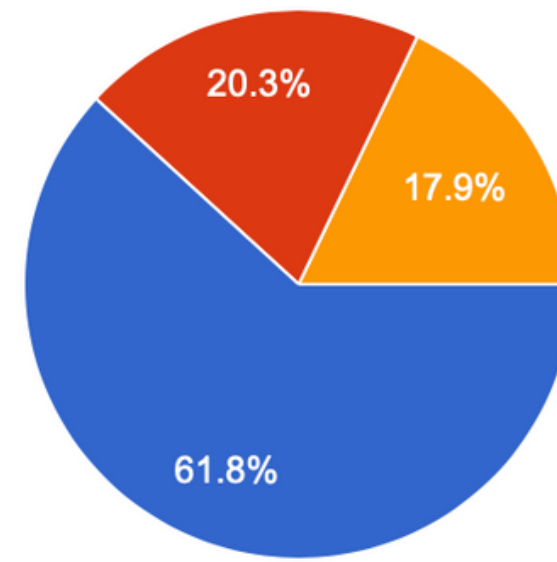

Given the data, will your student return to in-person instruction once the benchmarks return to the yellow/moderate spread category?

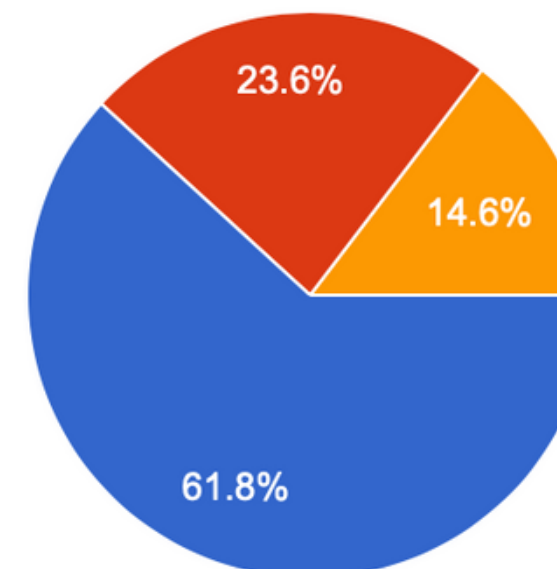

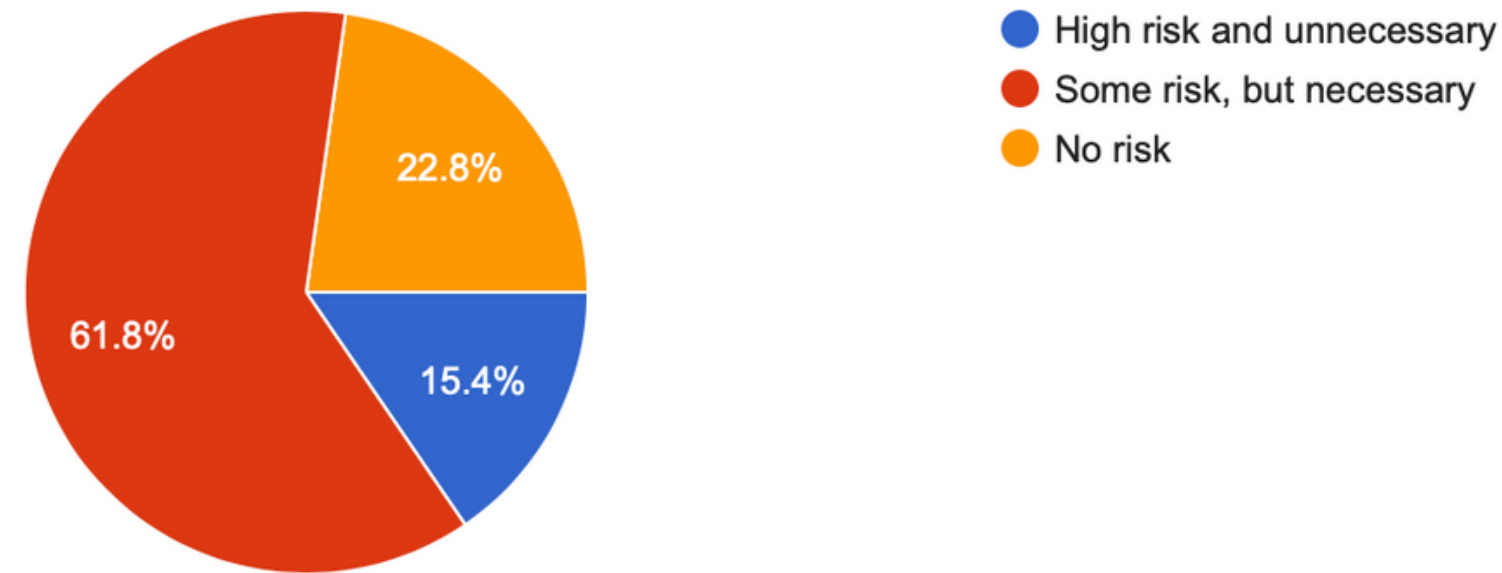


- My student would return to in-person learning.

Return to in-person instruction survey results: level of risk

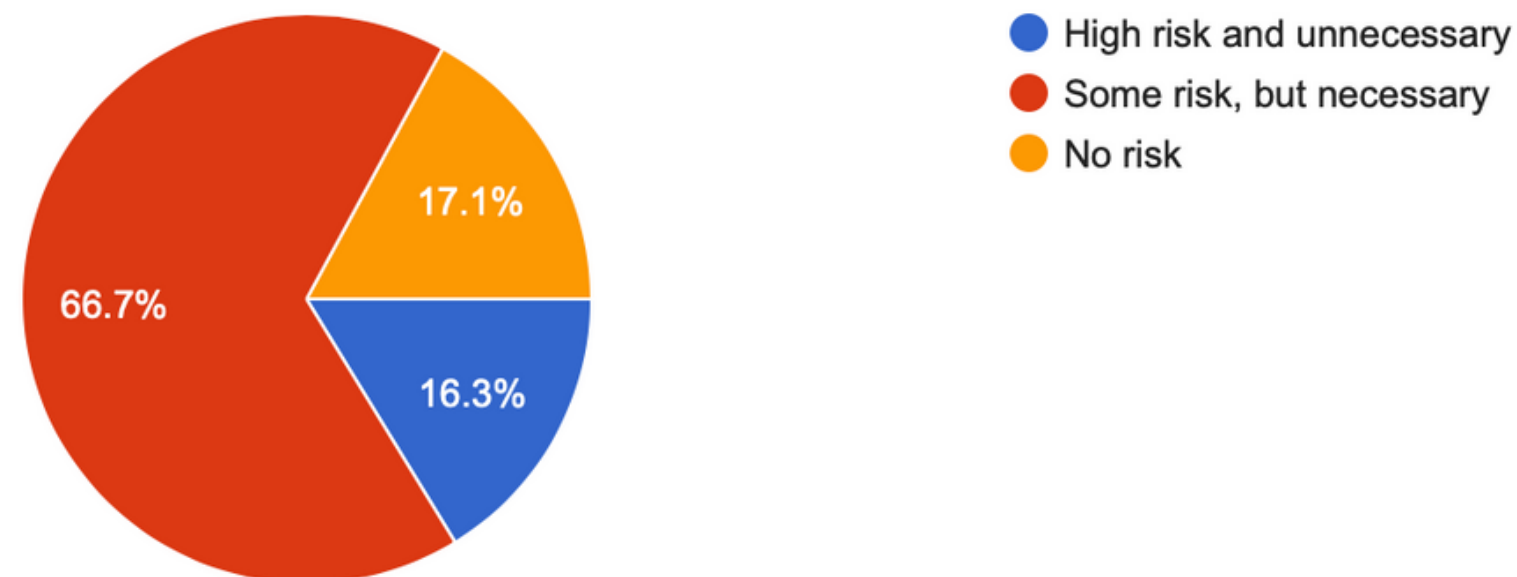
Given the data, what level of risk do you feel exists for the students if there is a return to in-person instruction?

Given the data, what level of risk do you feel exists for the staff if there is a return to in-person instruction?

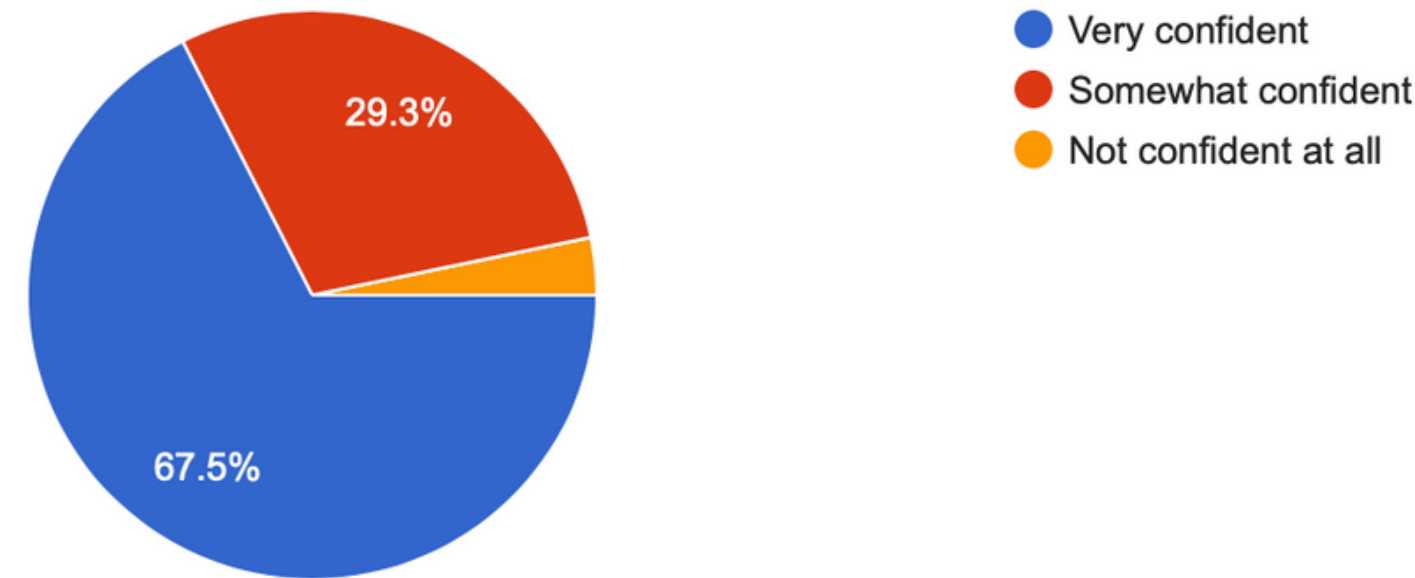

What is this dashboard?

ADHS County-Level School Benchmarks
This dashboard is used to determine the level of community spread of COVID-19 in Arizona and assist with decision making for the types of delivery model schools may consider.

Time Frame
This dashboard does not look at the past two weeks due to potential lags in data.

Substantial Transmission
>100 cases per 100k, >10% percent positivity, >10% COVID-like illness

Moderate Transmission
10 - 100 cases per 100k, 5 - 10% percent positivity, 5 - 10% COVID-like illness

Minimal Transmission
<10 cases per 100k, <5% percent positivity, <5% COVID-like illness

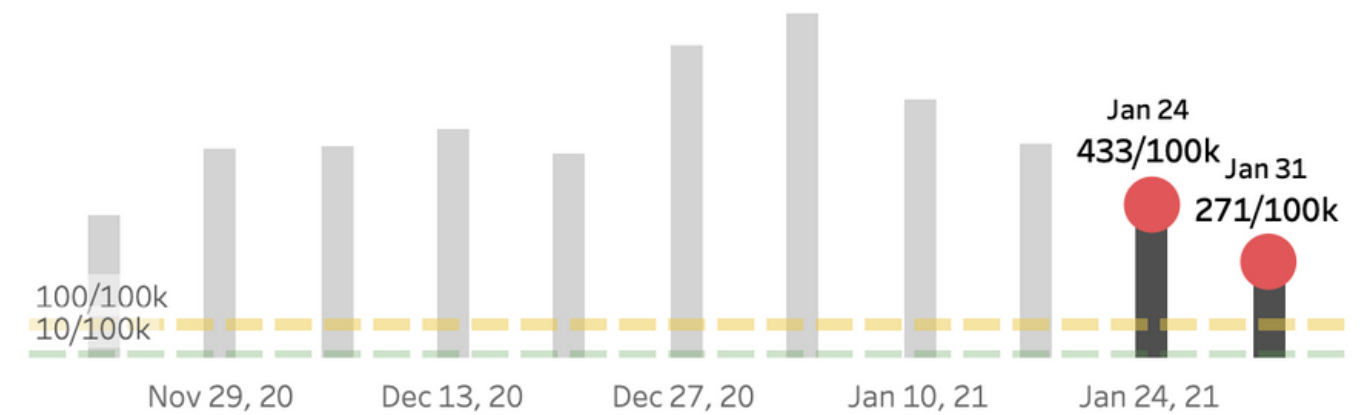

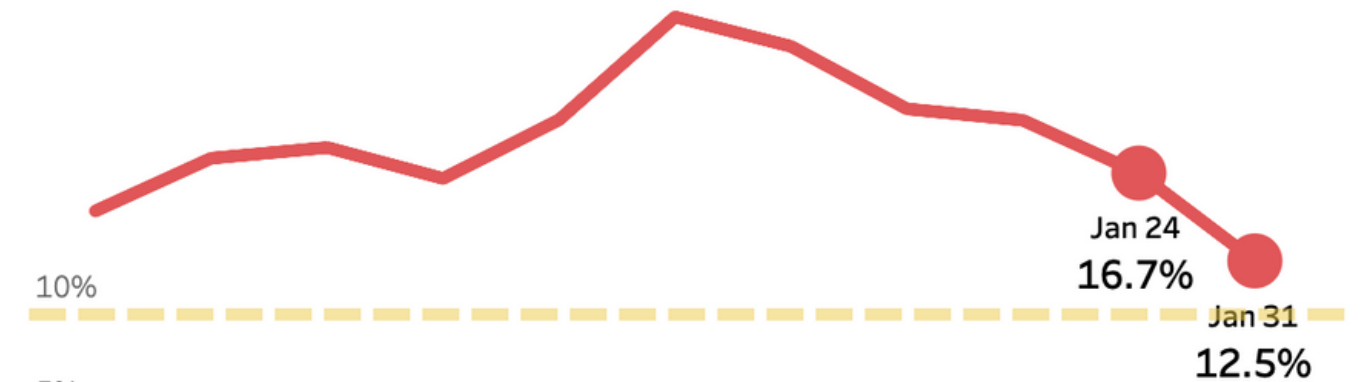

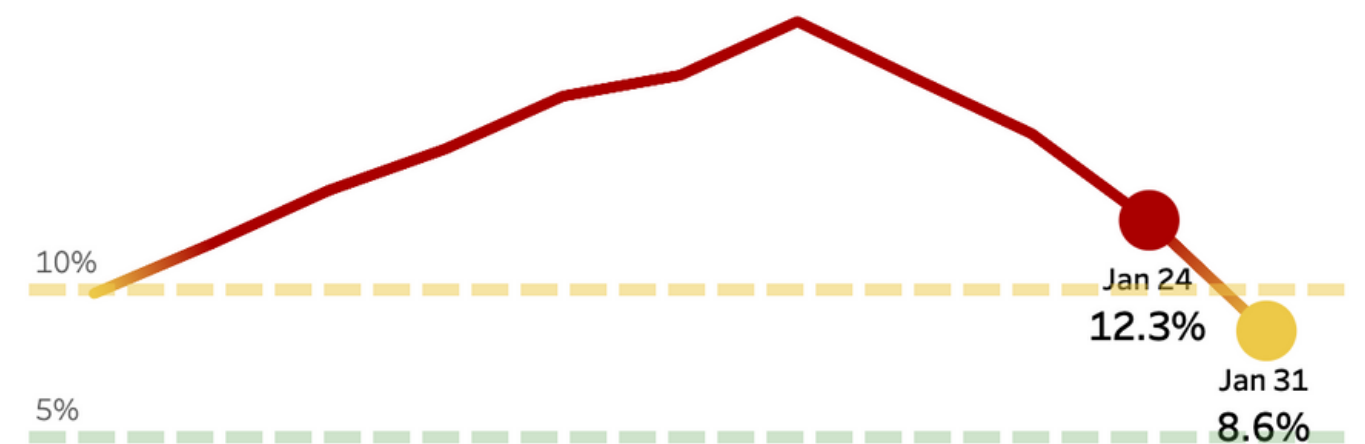
1) Cases per 100,000 individuals
