- The registration fee for the ACT (no writing) is \$36.50. This includes reports for you, your high school (if you authorize the reporting), and up to four college choices (if valid codes are provided when you register).
- The registration fee for the ACT Plus Writing is \$52.50. This includes reports for you, your high school (if you authorize the reporting), and up to four college choices (if valid codes are provided when you register). The \$16.00 Writing test fees is refundable, on written request, if you are absent on the test day or switch to the ACT (No Writing) before you begin testing.
