Family and Community Engagement Frequently Asked Questions - FAQ

1. Will my child be required to wear a uniform?

Students are expected to wear uniforms to school. During virtual learning students are expected to wear a school uniform.

2. Will the school district provide transportation?

The bus arrangements are being finalized with ECCO Ride. More details will be shared.

3. How will the school serve meals to the students?

The meals will be served in the classroom.

4. How will the district serve meals to students on virtual learning?

Parents will come to the schools and pick up meals once or twice a week. Look for more information in the coming weeks.

5. Can parents send snacks?

Parents are welcome to send individual snacks and water bottles.

6. When are schools opening?

Schools are scheduled to open Monday, August 10, 2020 for students.

7. How will schools dismiss?

The student will end the day based on the virtual or hybrid schedule school leaders have published.

8. How will the school monitor attendance?

Students will be expected to login. Teachers will take attendance daily via online and report attendance to the office.

9. If my child has an underlying health condition, do I have to provide documentation?

Yes, please provide documentation for the child participating in virtual learning.

10. Will my child have recess and/or specials?

There will not be any recess or specials in the elementary school. There will be time for stretch breaks. There will be health in the middle and high schools.

11. Can parents visit their child's teacher?

At this time, parents are not allowed to visit their child's teacher. However, a parent may make arrangements through the school's office. There will be a virtual open house for parents and teachers to connect.

12. How will social distance be practiced in the schools?

The school administrators and their teams have been planning to space desks six feet in the same direction.

13. How will students receive grades?

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The teacher will submit grades through SAMS. Parents may view grades in Active Parent.

14. What professional development will be provided to parents to assist their children with virtual learning?

Professional development will be provided to parents. More dates and times are coming.

15. What cleaning plans are in place to prevent the spread?

Classrooms, offices, bathrooms will be cleaned on a regular basis throughout the day.

16. What happens if a teacher, student, or worker tests positive for the virus?

In the event someone tests positive for the disease, the school is expected to notify the all stakeholders immediately while maintaining confidentiality.

17. Will my child be allowed to drink water from the fountain?

No one will be allowed to drink from the fountain. Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottles.

18. Will the school provide my child with a mask?

The school will provide the students a mask. However, students are encouraged to bring their own masks.

19. Will the school district provide the students with an email address?

The school is planning to assign each student an email address.

20. How will the school communicate with families?

Each school is asking parents to notify the school office of any updates to contact information such as telephones, cell phones, and addresses. The school district strongly encourages parents to access and use Active Parent. School leaders will gladly assist with enrolling parents.

21. Will the school district provide my child with a computer?

The school district will provide students with computers as soon as funding is available. The school district is waiting on guidance from MDE.
