RE: Parent Teacher Conferences Scheduled

Greetings NCS D Family,

This letter is sent with high importance from the Office of the State Transformation Interim Superintendent.

Student progress reports for the first term of the 2020 – 2021 school year were sent out on this past Thursday, September 10, 2020 to your child’s email that he/she uses to sign into Microsoft Teams for Virtual Learning. If you have not reviewed your child’s progress report, please do so before you meet with teachers for Parent Teacher Conferences. Receiving progress reports prior to Parent Teacher Conferences should allow for candid conversations with your child/ren teachers.

Parent Teacher Conferences are scheduled for this upcoming Tuesday, September 15, 2020. Conferences will be held virtually through Microsoft Teams via your child’s Teams account. The conference schedule is 11:00 AM – 6:00 PM. Teachers will have lunch from 2:00 PM – 3:00 PM and will not be available during that time. Once teachers return from lunch, they will be available from 3:00 PM – 6:00 PM. Parents are advised to reach out to their child’s teacher via email to schedule the conference. Please note, this will be the only formal day for Parent Teacher Conferences.

Additionally, Tuesday, September 15, 2020 will be designated as a Distance Learning Assignment Day. There will be no “Live” instruction through Microsoft TEAMS. Students will be asked to log into each class and complete at least one assignment assigned by the teacher to be counted present for the day. If your child does not complete an assignment, he/she will be counted absent for the day (September 15, 2020). Students who normally report to the school campus will not report to school on that day. Buses will not transport students. Students assigned to self-contained classrooms will be provided a written assignment to complete at home and submit the next school day to be counted present.

Finally, Tuesday, September 15, 2020, NCS D will host a “Live” briefing from the Office of the State Transformation Interim Superintendent to provide updates concerning the 2020 – 2021 school year.

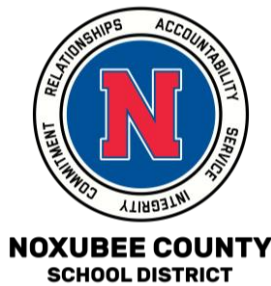
