## Promenade, Prom and After Prom Party- May 22-23, 2020

Q- What time is the promenade this year?

Q-Is attendance mandatory for seniors?

Q-When do seniors need to report and what should they wear?

## **Graduation-Wednesday, May 27, 2020 at 5 PM**

Q-How many tickets are given to each graduate and when do they receive them?

- A. Four tickets are given to each senior following the mandatory graduation rehearsal on May 18<sup>th</sup>.

Q-Does a baby need a ticket?

- A. Children under the age of two years old do not need a ticket as long as they sit on an adult's lap. All other guests, including those in wheelchairs, require a ticket.

Q-Where can we park for graduation?

- A. Parking is available on a first come, first served basis in the school parking lot and at neighboring St. Julie's Church. A shuttle will run between St. Julie's and Bishop Stang *before graduation only*.

Q-Is handicapped parking available?

Q-What do we do if we have guests with no tickets?

- A. Those without tickets may view the ceremony via closed circuit television in our cafeteria. Children under the age of twelve must be accompanied by an adult.

Q-Do seniors need to pay for their caps and gowns?

- A. No, they are included in the graduation fee.
