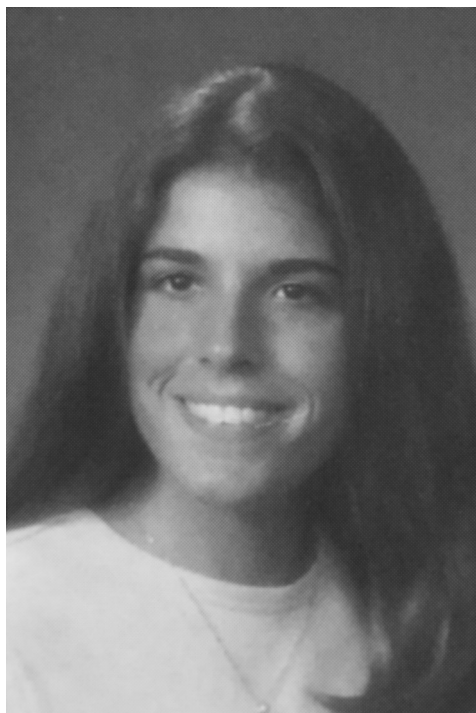

STEADFAST

For 20 years, Erin Harrington led all scorers in basketball, boys and girls, with a record of 1,672 points scored during her career at Bishop Stang. The record was only surpassed in 2019. Erin fell in love with basketball in the second grade while playing in the Milliken-Silva League in Fall River. A gifted athlete, Erin was also an outstanding soccer player, and contributed to both the softball and track and field teams during her years at Bishop Stang, but basketball was her first love. She was the team's high scorer, and an EAC all-star for 4 straight years. Her senior year, Erin won the prestigious Dave Cowens award. During her senior season, Erin averaged more than 20 points per game and 13 rebounds per game, while shooting 72% from the free throw line. In addition to her unmatched shooting skills, teammates loved to play with her, and her coaches valued her ability to make the players around her better. A natural leader, Erin was captain of the basketball and track and field teams during her senior year. Erin was a member of the National Honor Society, driven in the classroom as she was on the court. After excelling at Stang, Erin went on to a successful career playing basketball at Tufts University.
