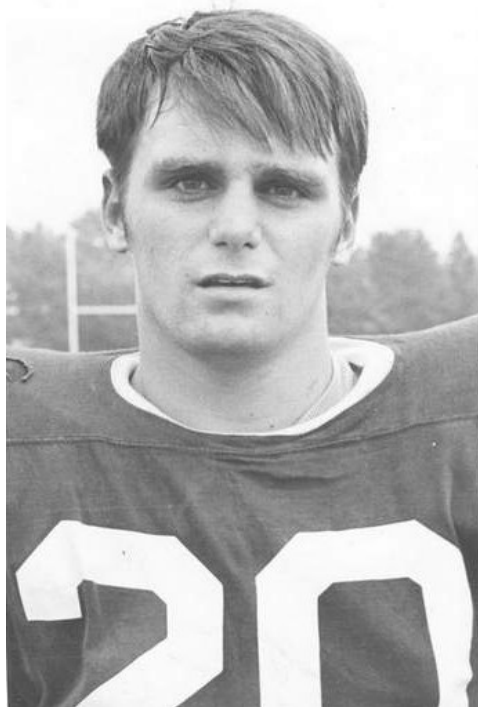




Bishop Stang High School 2019 Athletics Hall of Fame

DYNAMIC

Jack played football, basketball and baseball at Bishop Stang. Coach O'Brien admired Jack's tenacity, and was determined to direct Jack's energy into sports at Bishop Stang. In football, Jack was a 5-foot-10, 170-pound running back, and a bundle of energy. He was elected all-county all star three times, and all-scholastic in the Boston Globe. Doyle led area players in scoring and yard rushing, and held all Spartan rushing records. He was described in the press as "a double threat who could run and pass." Praised by Coach Charlie Connell as "the ultimate player," Doyle was respected by opponents for his mental and physical toughness. Despite battling with injuries that kept him sidelined off and on, he rushed for 1,929 yards in his football career at Stang, leading the Stang team in rushing yards twice. A team-player in basketball, he motivated teammates and pushed the best skilled players to play faster and harder through his . Jack played third base and had a strong bat on the baseball team, rounding out his three-season schedule. Local sports writer Buddy Thomas remembers him as one of the most dynamic football players to ever play in our area, commenting that "big plays at big times was what this guy was all about."
